
COVID-19: Rights and obligations of temporary workers

Your rights

The user company cannot

- compel you to take leave,
- require you to sign a termination of your contract by mutual agreement.

When the user company or the interim company has given you an exemption from service, you must be paid normally until the expiration of your assignment contract.

Finally, you have the right to be adequately protected. The minimum distance from your colleagues and customers must be respected and other measures may have to be taken depending on your workstation. Inform your employer when you are a person at risk.

Your obligations

You cannot decide yourself to stay at home. This decision is up to your employer.

If your employer has not specifically asked you to stay at home, you must report to work.
